Some serious subjects were discussed led by Delia Sworm, CNS and Charlotte McDowell from the Fountain Centre. The messages about covering up in the sun were felt to be very important at this time of year, and it was agreed more information would be put on the MelaNoMore website. The arrangements for patient access and movement within The Hospital during Covid – 19 were also covered and this helped reassure some who had concerns over going into The Hospital. Useful information was exchanged about face masks.
